Professor Castex graduated from the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in 1968 and was awarded a doctorate from Paris VIII University in 1997 with a thesis on the seventeenth-century French architect Francois Mansart. He has published several books and articles on urban studies, including *Urban Forms, the Death and Life of the Urban Block* (1977), which he authored with Ph. Panerai and J. Ch. Depaule. His 1989 book on architecture of the fifteenth through the nineteenth centuries, *Renaissance, Baroque, Classicisme, 1420-1720*, was re-edited in 2004 and has been translated into Dutch and Spanish.
