By the thirties Best began painting pin-ups and calendar art. In 1931 he published his best known book, *The Peter Pan Picture Book*.

In the early forties, Best was hired by Brown and Bigelow; the publisher of Gil Elvgren, Norman Rockwell, Maxfield Parrish, Cassius Marcellus Coolidge ("Dogs Playing Poker") and many other successful artists. He went on to a lucrative and successful career.
